 656 – 661 : Ali ibn Abi Talib r.a. (lived 598-661)

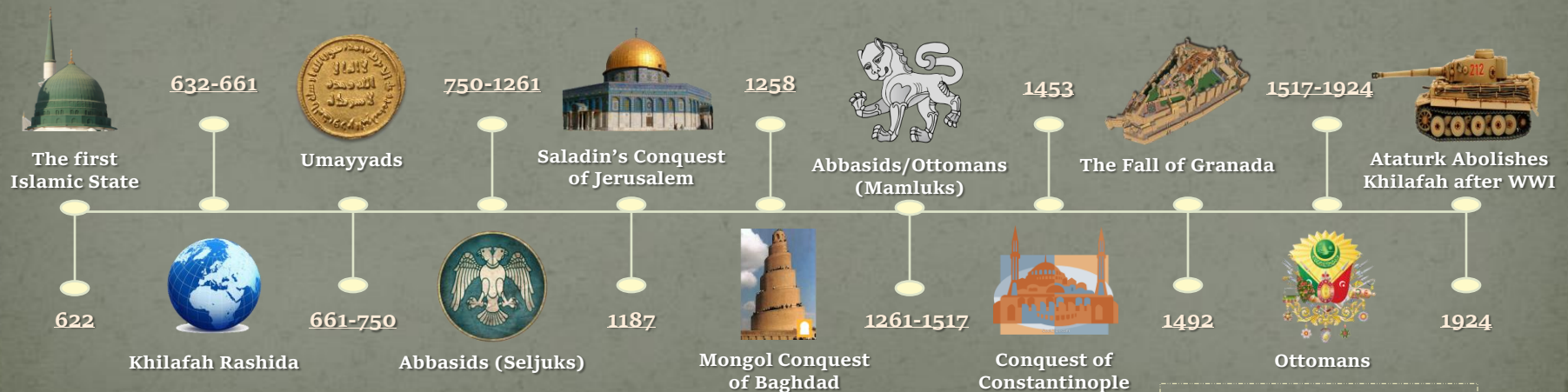
Major Scholars of Islam (699-855 CE)

699 – 767 : Abu Hanifah (Hanafi Madhab)
 711 – 795 : Malik ibn Anas (Maliki Madhab)
 767 – 820 : Al Shafi'i (Shafi'i Madhab)
 780– 855 : Ahmad ibn Hanbal (Hanbali Madhab)
 Madhab = "way to act"

 (Sahih Bukhari 7,275 Hadith)
 815 – 875 : Imam Muslim
 (Sahih Muslim 9,200 Hadith)
 817 – 889 : Abu Dawud
 (Sunan Abu Dawud 4,800 Hadith)
 824 – 887 : Ibn Majah
 (Sunan Ibn Majah 4,000+ Hadith)
 824 – 892 : Al Tirmidhi
 (Jami Al Tirmidhi 1,000 Hadith)
 819 – 915 : Al Nasa'i
 (Sunan Al Sughra 5,270 Hadith)

Huthayfa (ra) narrated that the Messenger of Allah (pbuh) said: Prophethood will remain among you as long as Allah wills. Then Caliphate (Khilafah) on the lines of Prophethood shall commence, and remain as long as Allah wills. Then corrupt/erosive monarchy would take place, and it will remain as long as Allah wills. After that, despotic kingship would emerge, and it will remain as long as Allah wills. Then, the Caliphate (Khilafah) shall come once again based on the precept of Prophethood (Hadith from Musnad Ahmad ibn Hanbal)



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
